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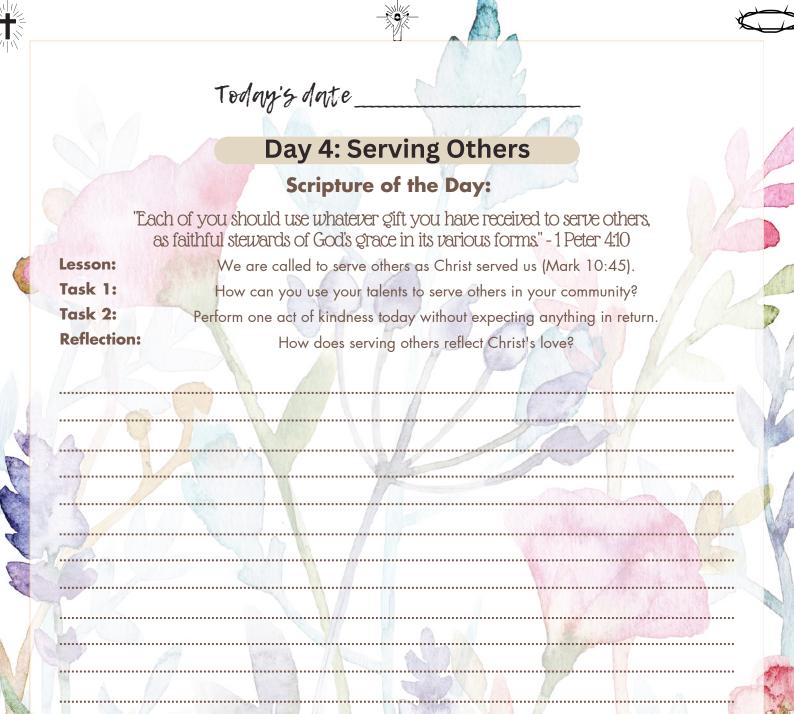




Day 3: Overcoming Challenges Scripture of the Day:

Reflection:	How has God's strength been evident in your life recently?	
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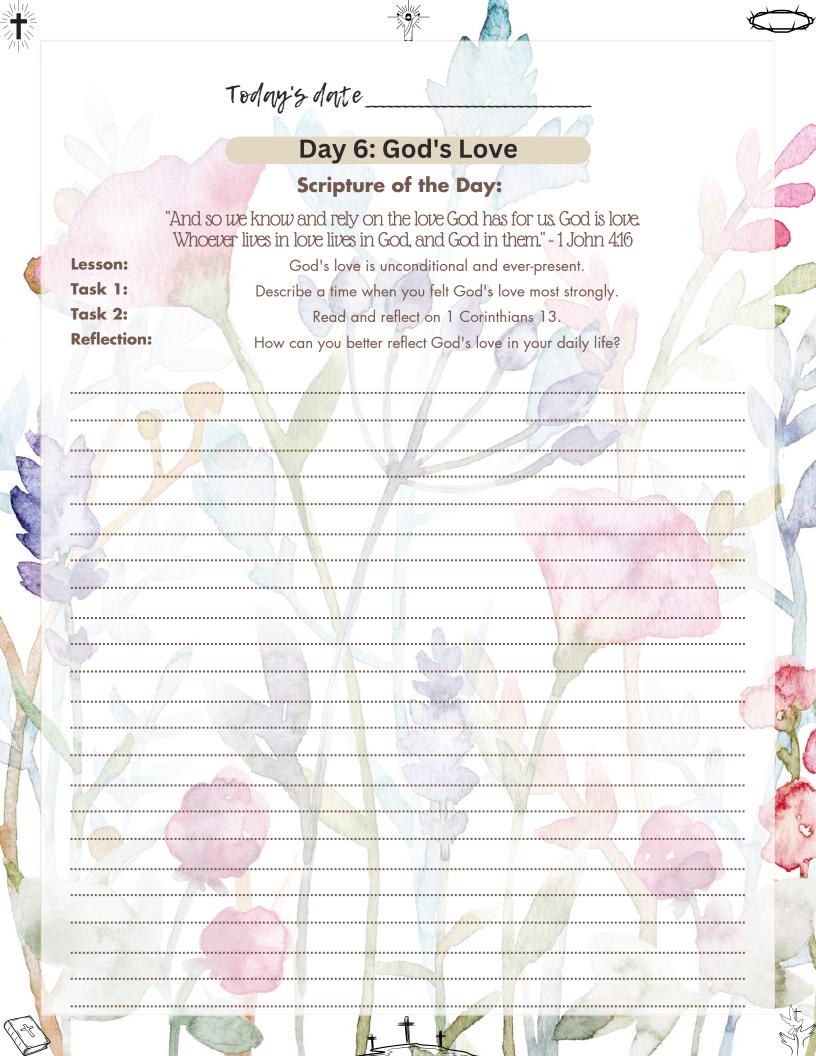




Day 5: Forgiveness Scripture of the Day:

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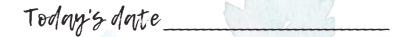
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Day 8: Prayer Life Scripture of the Day:

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Reflection: How can a varied prayer life deepen your relationship with God?	

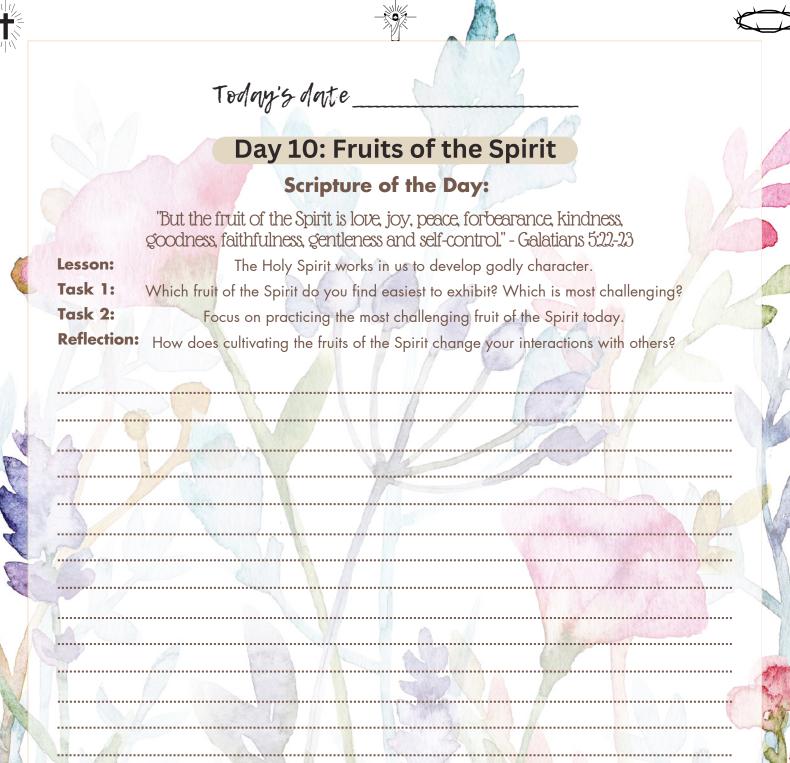


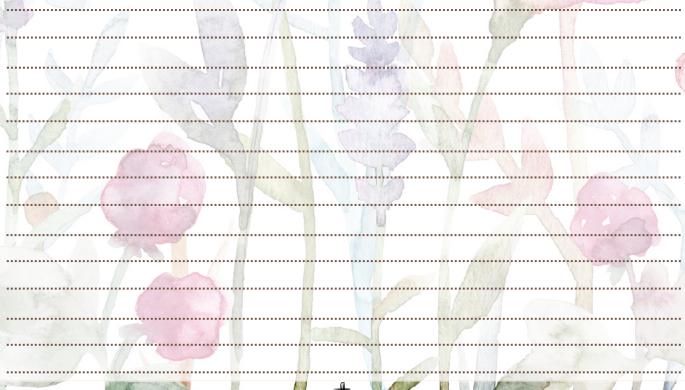


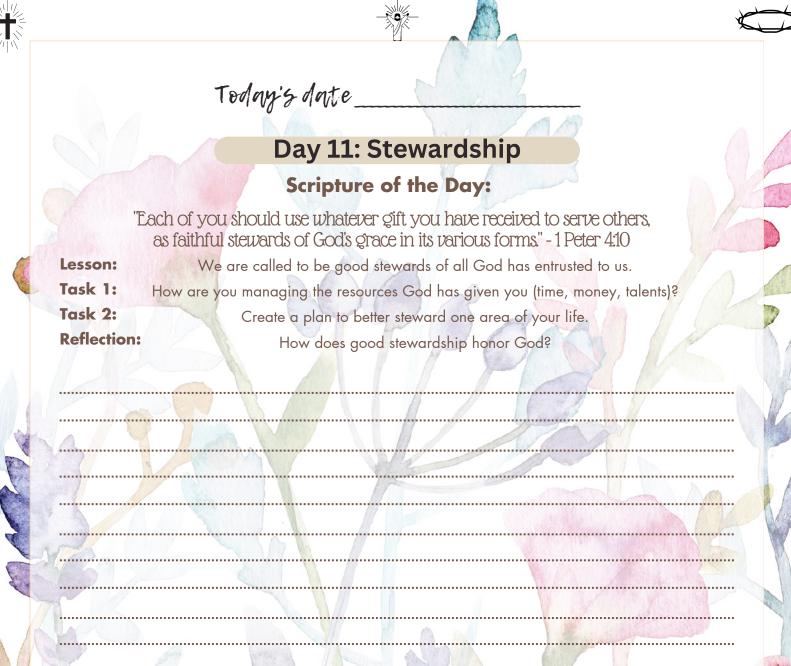
Day 9: Faith and Doubt Scripture of the Day:

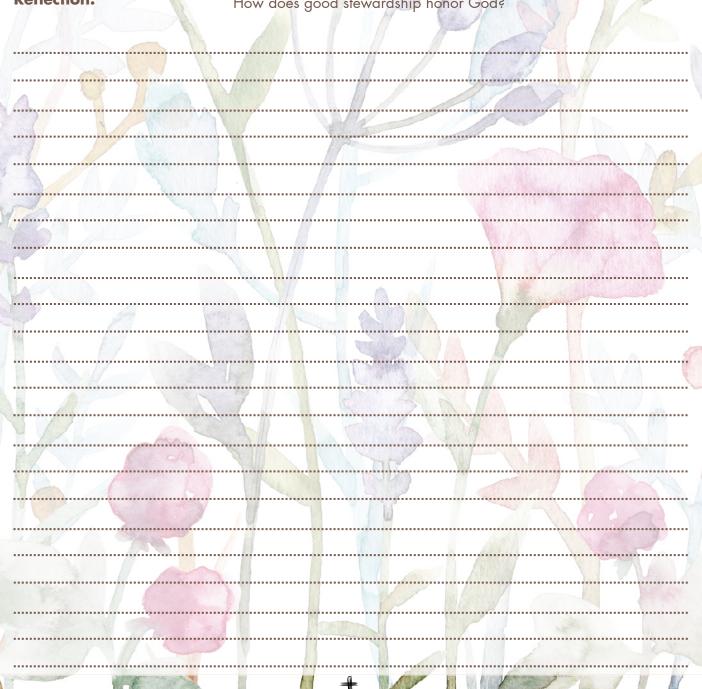
"Immediately the boy's father exclaimed, I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!" - Mark 9:24

Reflection	How can doubt lead to a stronger faith?
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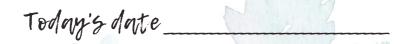


Day 12: Worship Scripture of the Day:

Reflection:	How can you incorporate more meaningful worship into your daily life?
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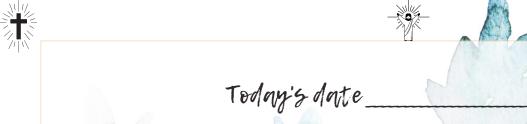




Day 13: Scripture Study Scripture of the Day:

"Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path." - Psalm 119:105

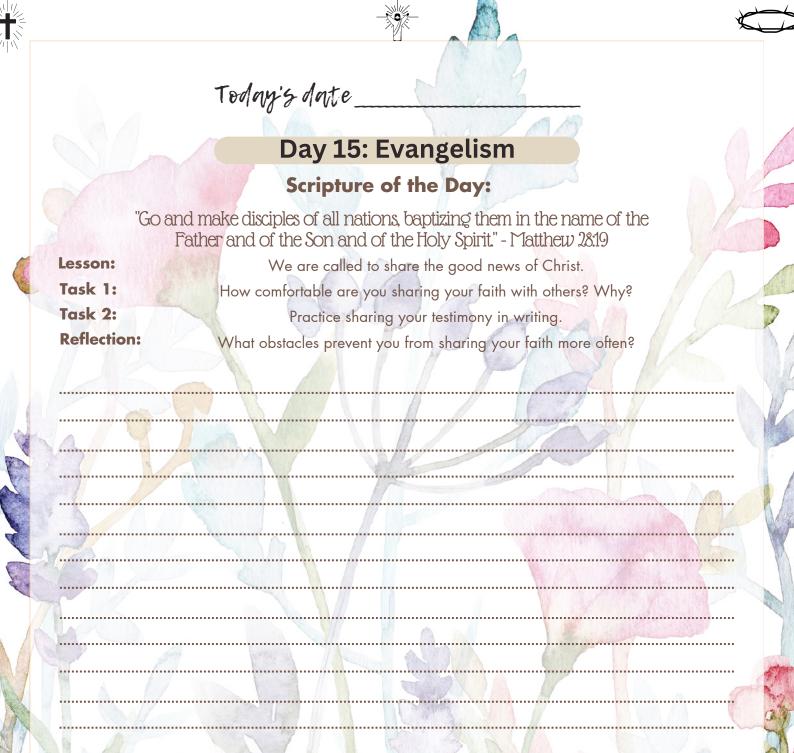

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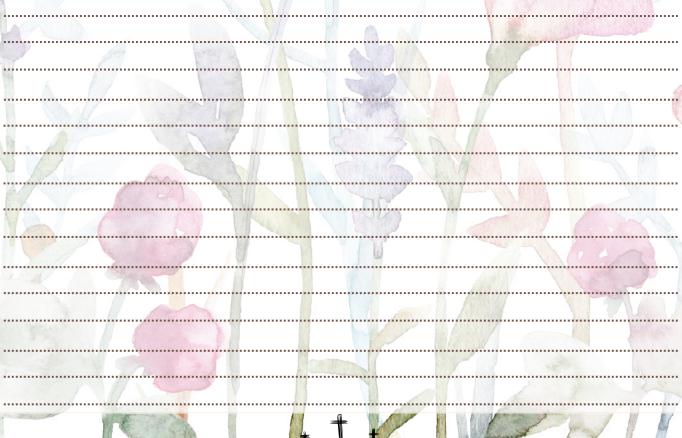


Day 14: Relationships Scripture of the Day:

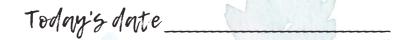

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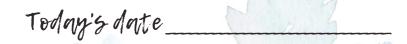


Day 16: Contentment Scripture of the Day:

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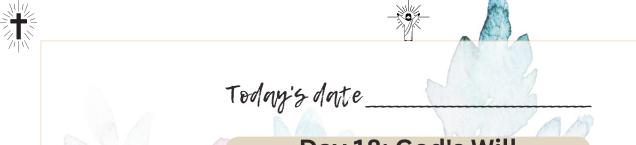

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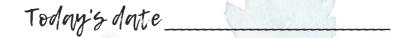


Day 18: God's Will Scripture of the Day:

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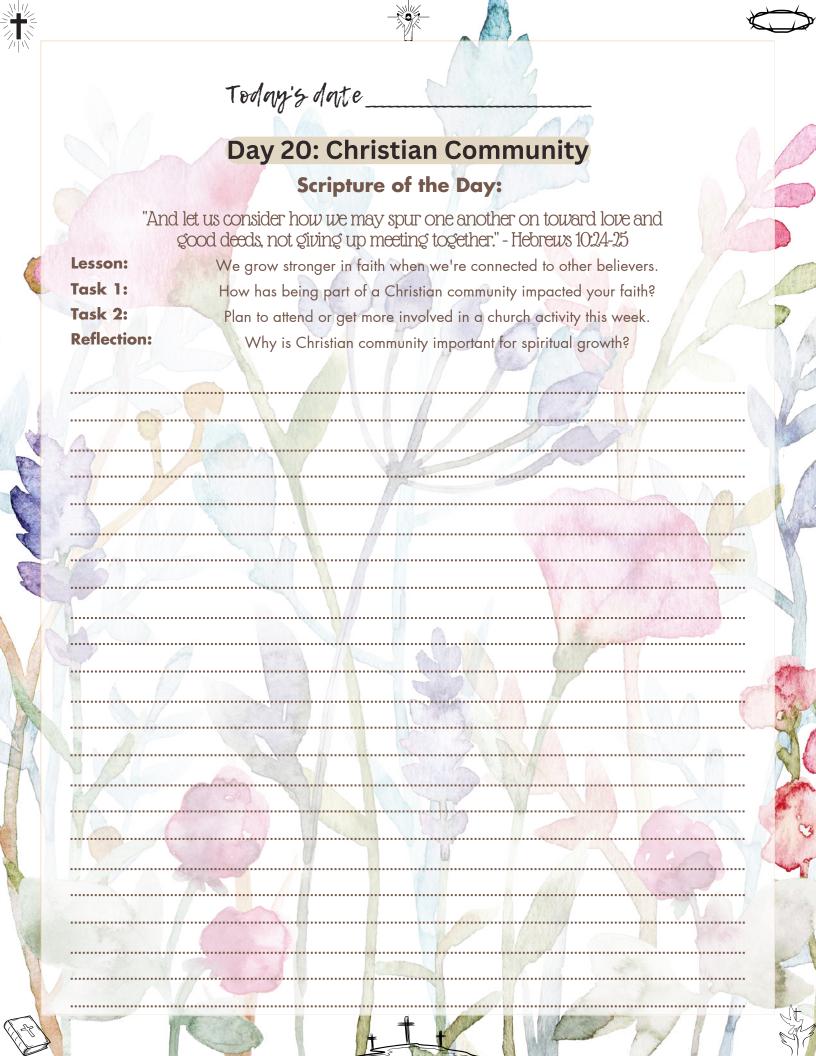


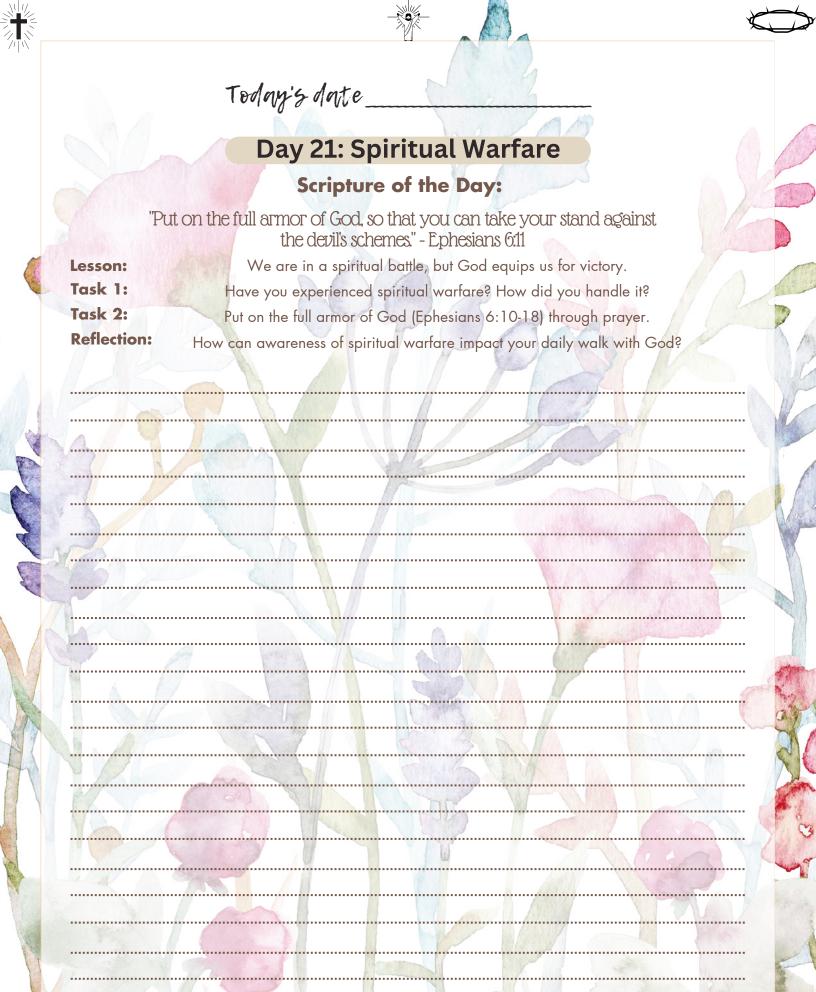


Day 19: Dealing with Temptation Scripture of the Day:

"No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear." - 1 Corinthians 10:13

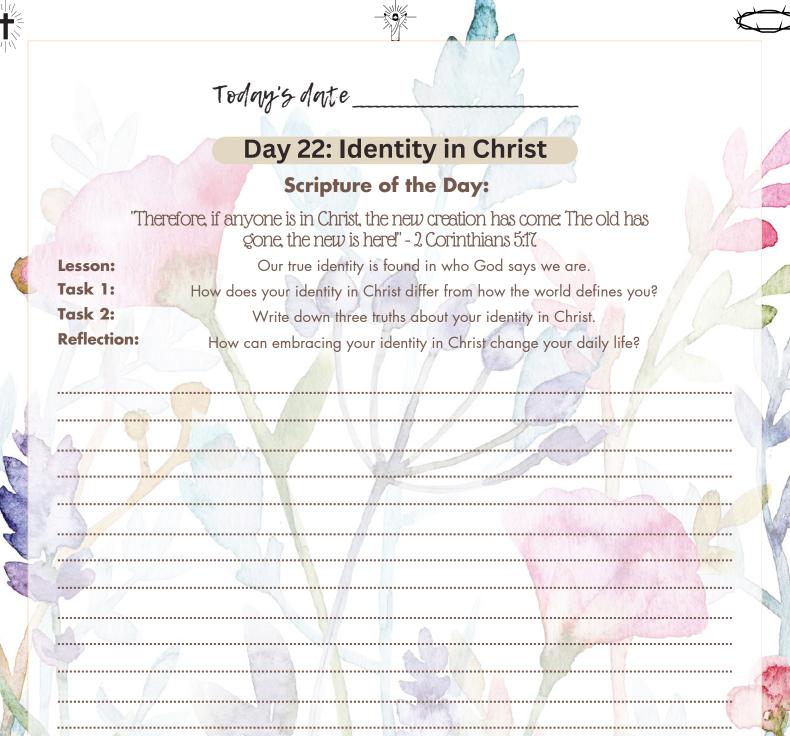

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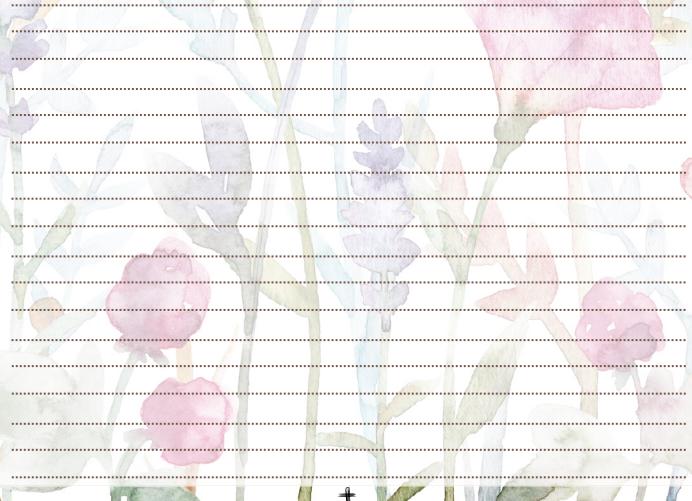


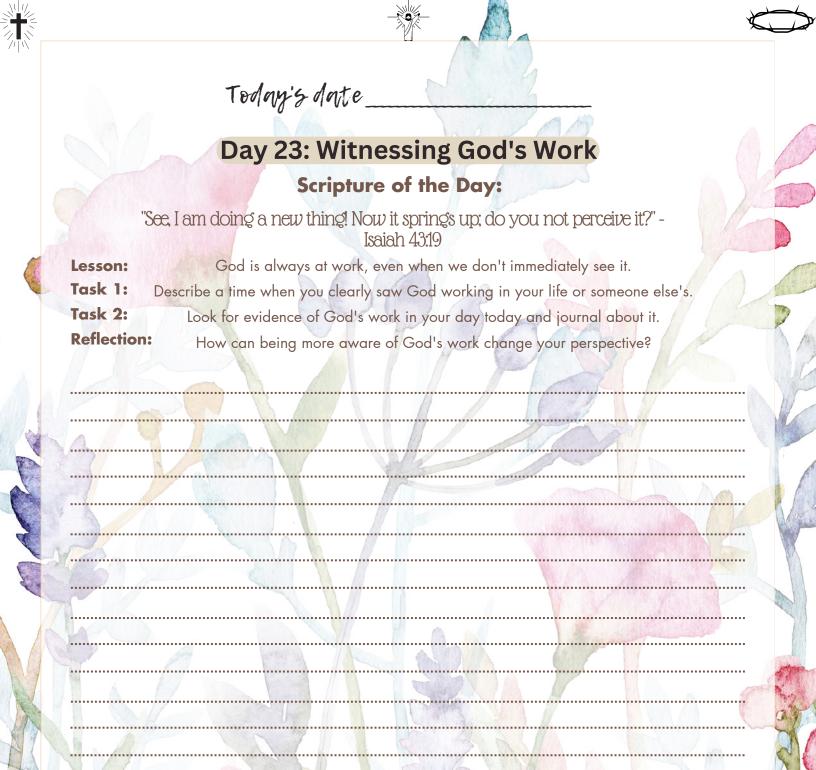






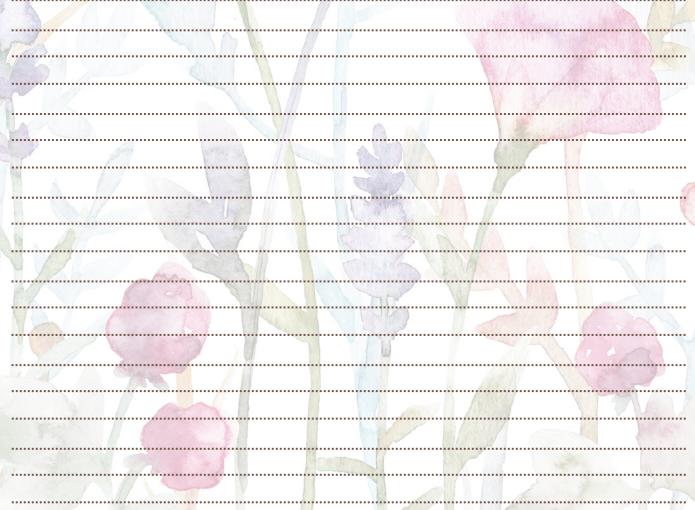


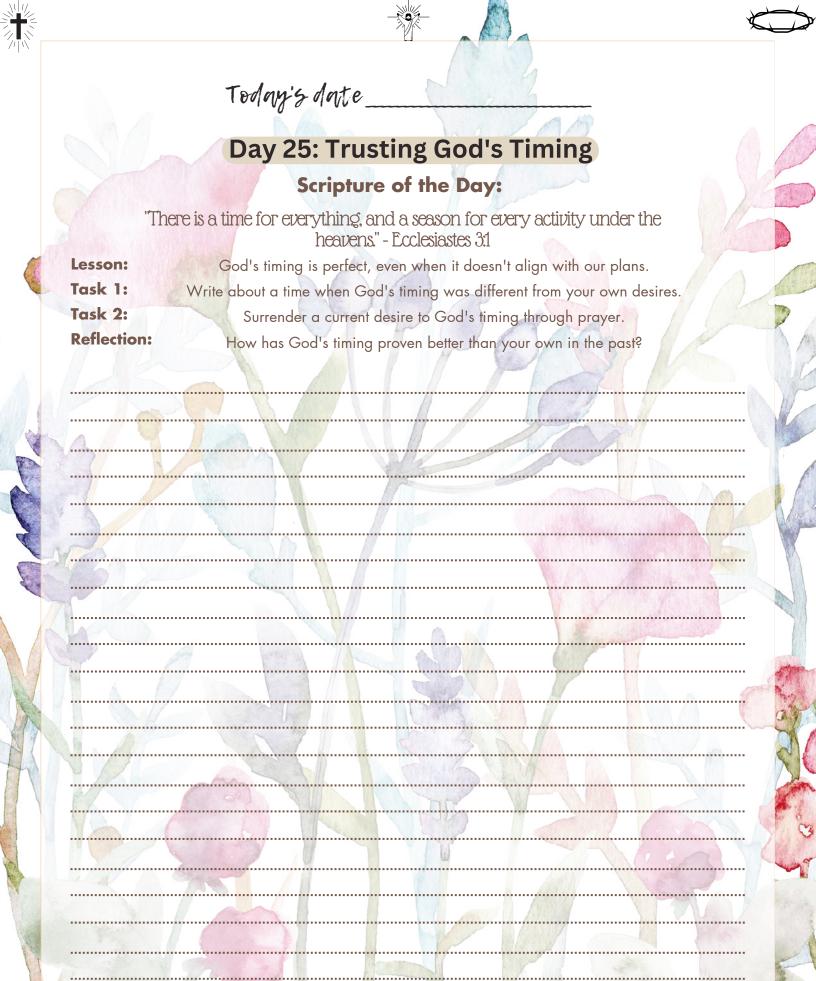






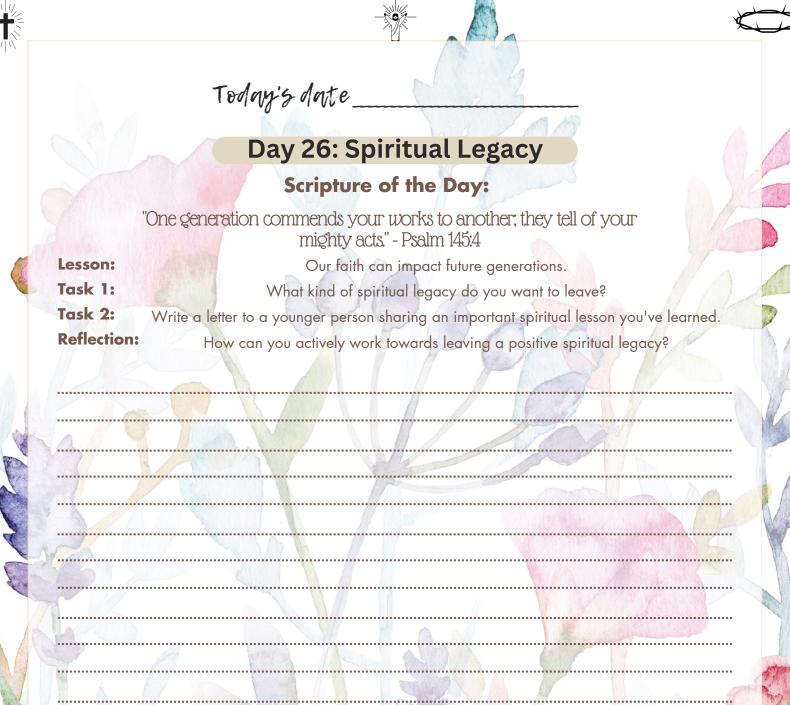
















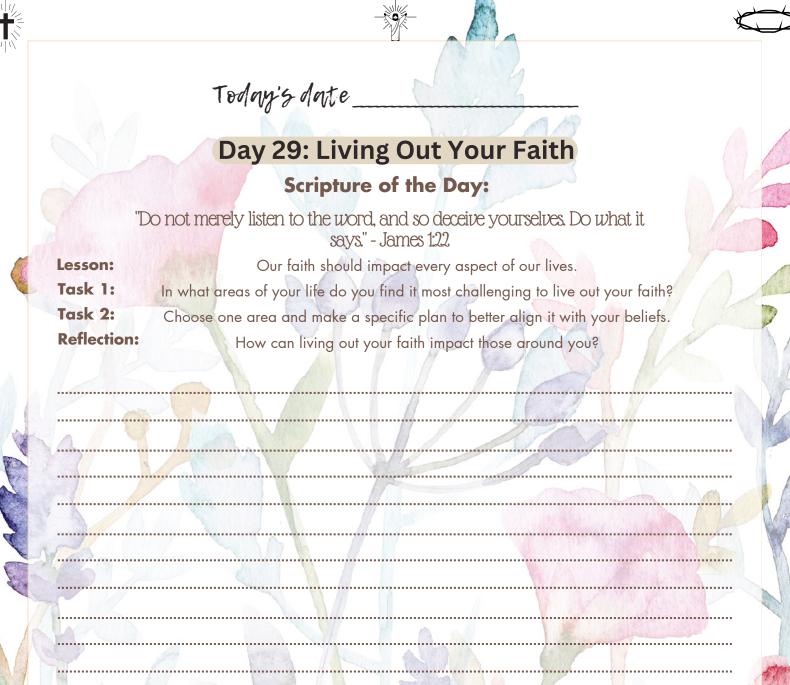


Day 28: Listening to God
